
Friendly reminder that SPRINGs challenge booklets are due to Mr Keyte with all the required evidence by the last Friday of term (October 1).

Examination Procedures and Conditions

Our Derived Grade Examinations will be sat under formal NCEA assessment conditions. Therefore ALL students sitting exams must follow the procedures below:

- Students sitting exams must arrive 10 mins before the exam starts so they can be let in early to start on time
- All students must work individually, NO talking or communicating with other students at all once inside the examination room
- Students are not allowed ANY food in the exam
- Water in a clear bottle is allowed
- No cellphones or watches are allowed at school for our DRG exams
- Students must write in blue or black pen ONLY. Answers written in pencil will not be marked
- If you run out of room in your answer booklet, put your hand up for extra paper, but you must use all of the extra paper on the exam paper first. You are NOT allowed to bring in any extra paper
- At the end of the exam remain seated and silent until you have been released by the teacher in charge; do not

talk until you are outside of the room

- You cannot leave the room in the first 30 minutes or the last 15 minutes of the exam. If you wish to leave the exam early, raise your hand and wait for the supervisor to take your work. You may then silently get up, take your belongings and leave the exam room
- Students are allowed to go to the toilet during an exam, but must leave all of their belongings in the exam room.
 Examiner to call Cherie in the office to let her know they are coming

Study Room Expectations

- If you don't have an exam, you will be in Room 18 studying
- If you need to visit a teacher to do other internal work, eg Art, D-Tech please let the study teacher know at the start of the session
- You are allowed to listen to music provided you have headphones in while you work
- No talking, it is a study room
- Do not walk past or congregate near the exam room
- No eating in the study room




