## Auckland Art Gallery Field Trip



On Wednesday the senior NCEA Visual Art students went to Auckland Art Gallery to see the amazing contemporary Maori Art exhibition Toi Tu Toi Ora. After a wee hiccup with the car parking building with our oversize van height, 10 students and two teachers headed to the landmark exhibition. The exhibition consumed the whole art gallery, showcasing the best sculpture, photography, video, painting, design and drawing from Maori artists over the last 70 years. It was wonderful for students to experience the scale of these artworks, as seeing artwork on a computer screen or in a book just doesn't have the same impact.

The students completed two activities at the gallery, a clue based scavenger hunt using their cellphones to photograph their answers and a personal response to 3 artworks which impacted them. The students will use these artists to help develop ideas for their NCEA artwork later on in the year. This inspiring exhibition closes 5pm this Saturday; it is definitely well worth the visit!

#### Year 12 & 13 — Paint ball





